June 20, Tuesday	Cap & gown distribution in the Auditorium immediately after school. Also, information on Handicapped Permits will be discussed. All obligations must be cleared. Seniors not cleared can pick up cap & gown after rehearsal on 6/21.
June 20, 21	Bag drop off for Project Graduation in the Freshman Café 7:15 – 12:15 PM
June 21, Wednesday	Seniors and ushers are to report to the Auditorium at 12:00 PM for graduation instruction. Attendance at practice is mandatory for participants in the graduation ceremony.
June 22, Thursday	GRADUATION DAY! Seniors and ushers report to Homeroom and then to the Auditorium for final graduation rehearsal when called. Tickets will be issued following practice.
June 22 – 5:00 PM	Seniors report to the New Wing with cap & gown to prepare for the processional. Your gown has been pressed, and your tassel is held in place on the RIGHT SIDE with a straight pin. Programs will be issued to Graduates there. BE READY TO LEAVE THE BUILDING AT 5:45 PM SHARP! No sunglasses please. Once the processional begins, if you are not there, you cannot participate.
June 22 – 5:45 PM	Processional departs at 5:45 PM. Ceremony starting time at Patriot's Stadium - 6:00 PM.
June 22 – 7:00 PM	Distribution of diplomas will conclude in room 116 immediately after the completion of the ceremony.
June 22 – 7:15 PM	Students will report to the Freshman Café to prepare for departure for Project Graduation. No senior will be allowed to drive themselves to campus for Project Graduation.

FOR GRADUATION NIGHT

Students are to arrive at school with their caps and gowns in hand. They are not to wear them into the building. Students will put their caps and gowns on once they arrive in the New Wing.

You are reminded that PARTICIPATION IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONY IS VOLUNTARY. Those who are not dressed appropriately under their academic gowns will not be permitted on the field – even at the last moment. Improper behavior on the field, including bringing any objects that can cause disruption (beach balls, silly string, etc.) will result in removal from the ceremony and withholding of your high school diploma. Please do not disappoint family and guests on this very important day in your life.

WARDROBE SUGGESTIONS – Appropriate light weight clothing is suggested. Girls - shoes without heels that will survive the walk to the stadium and requirements for the turf field. Boys – collared shirt, dress pants and dress shoes – tie optional.

At completion of graduation students will report to room 116 to obtain their diplomas.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Parking - A shuttle bus will be available from the front of the school to Patriot's Stadium for people needing assistance. Special handicapped parking permits must be requested in writing to Richard Porfido by June 21st. Tickets - you will receive 2 indoor tickets following practice on June 22, 2017, for use in case of inclement weather.

- **For security reasons the school will be locked during and after commencement. ONLY graduates will be permitted to enter the rear breezeway to receive diplomas. This will require you to say your goodbyes and take photos before the graduate enters the building.**
